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## Community Group Questions Sunday November 27th

### THE UPSIDE DOWN KINGDOM-SPIRITUALLY BROKE

1. This week begin with prayer requests. Spend as much time as you need praying for each other.

### Read- Matthew 5:1-3, Isaiah 57:15

2. Do you think it is coincidence that as soon as Jesus sits down with His disciples the first statement He shares with them is *-you will have godlike joy when you come to the understanding that you are spiritually poor?* Can you truly enter the kingdom of God if you are not willing to be broken (repentant?).
3. Denial keeps God from working in your life because it keeps you from honestly dealing with your issues. *Denial is defined as a false system of beliefs that are not based upon reality.* Why is that we/others choose denial rather than to be healed by God?
4. Read Isaiah 57:15 again. Discuss this truth. Revival comes through brokenness. *(revive means to make alive) If I want to be alive in the Spirit's power then I must allow my 'self' to die.*
5. Discuss the beauty of brokenness in the church. If the people in the church are not willing to be broken will we ever impact the hurting people in the world? Discuss the differences of a "self righteous church" and a "broken church".
6. How do we maintain the attitude of being spiritually poor while at the same time realizing that in Christ we are spiritually rich? How do we limit God when we make our issues bigger than Him?
